



Academy Program Rules

A. Attendance

1. Please arrive at the field 15 minutes before the start time of a game or practice.
2. Please notify our academy staff via email of any absences in advance so that we can plan accordingly.

B. Conduct - Players

1. To participate in events, a player must comply with the following items.
 - a. Wear the proper uniform for games.
 - b. Wear shin guards
 - c. Wear proper footwear - cleats (outdoor events) or indoor shoes (indoor events)
 - d. Bring water
 - e. Bring a soccer ball
2. A player must treat everyone with respect to participate.
 - a. Verbal abuse, physical abuse, or profanity is not acceptable.
 - b. Show teammates that you care by providing maximum effort and a positive attitude.
3. FSCI reserves the right to remove a player from activities, events, or the program for the following reasons.
 - a. verbal abuse, physical abuse, or threats
 - b. poor attitude, disrespect, or misconduct

C. Conduct – Parents & Guardians

1. Do not instruct the players. It leads to confusion and unnecessary conflict.
2. Do not engage in verbal abuse, physical abuse, or outward public displays of criticism of players, referees, officials, or coaches.
3. Do not interfere with coaches, referees, or officials actively involved in games or practices.
4. Do not offer input into roster decisions, gameday decisions, practice decisions, or any coaching decisions.
5. FSCI reserves the right to remove a player from an activity or the program for any parent interference, parental instruction, or parental misconduct.
6. Parents must pick up their child no later than 15 minutes after the end of a practice, game, or other event.

D. Communication

1. All events are posted on the calendar on our website. If it is not on the calendar, it does not exist.
2. Cancellations or same-day schedule changes are posted on the FSCI social media pages.
3. It is the responsibility of the parent and player to review the calendar and monitor our social media pages prior to attending any event.
4. Our staff is happy to discuss where your child needs improvement or any issue specific to your child.
5. Parents are responsible for knowing all club provided communications that includes but is not limited to club emails, parent meetings, social media postings, etc.

E. Other Issues

1. No one may use the club logo or any of its intellectual property for merchandising, t-shirts, or other usage without the express written permission of the Executive Director.
2. A player and parent must comply with any FSCI safety or health protocols.
3. FSCI reserves the right to require a parent to submit a medical release form for the child to participate.
4. FSCI reserves the right to require a parent to submit a birth certificate for the child to participate.
