The Fredericksburg Soccer Club Incorporated (FSCI), a youth soccer club based in Fredericksburg, VA, has an opening for a Director of Coaching Education. FSCI offers a travel soccer program, rec academy program, and training programs.

**Director of Coaching Education:** Full time position available. The Director of Coaching Education will lead all education aspects for all programs in the club. We are looking for an energetic person that enjoys working with youth and engaging with full and part-time staff.

Essential Job Functions include but are not limited to:

- Mentor and train all coaches on issues related to child development, leadership, motivation, periodization, and the mental aspect of the game
- Supervise coaches in developing effective learning objectives and practice plans within the scope of the club style of play
- Ensure a high-quality player development environment
- Oversee a video analysis program for coaches and players
- Maintain a library of model activities for coaches and players
- Assess individual player growth
- Implement and formalize club culture initiatives
- Support event logistics such as camps, leagues, tournaments, etc.

Requirements for the Position:

1. Hold a USSF C License or USC Advanced National Diploma (candidates with a USSF D License or equivalent USC diploma holding an advanced degree in the field of child development will be considered)
2. Strong planning and organizational skills
3. Strong communication and conflict resolution skills
4. Ability to demonstrate technical skills and soccer knowledge
5. Have an outgoing, charismatic personality with the ability to effectively communicate with all stakeholders.
6. Proven computer skills, specifically using spreadsheets, presentations, word processors, etc.

At least TWO of the following desired attributes:

1. Have the USSF National Youth License
2. Ability to speak both English and Spanish
3. Previous work experience as a teacher or psychologist
4. Have a background in nutrition for athletes
5. Played the game at the high school, college, or professional level

6. Bachelor's Degree from an accredited school in either education, psychology, or a social science related discipline

Compensation: Salary starts at \$50,000. Benefits include health insurance and up to 5 weeks of paid leave. Performance reviews will occur every 6-12 months.
