

2020 FSCI Event Arrival and Departure Protocol

Effective July 1, 2020 in accordance with State of Virginia Phase III Guidelines

If a player thinks he or she is sick, please stay home.

If a coach, administrator, or official has a concern about a player's health, he or she has the authority to send the player home.

Players should only plan to attend during their specific practice times.

ARRIVAL

1. Single file vehicle line - Players must remain in vehicles. Parents/players shall arrive by vehicle to the training or game site and enter a designated line for check-in. Specific check-in locations at each site will be provided. Players must remain in vehicles.
2. Temperature check - At the front of the line and while remaining in their vehicles, players' temperatures will be checked by an attending coach or volunteer. Any player recording a temperature at or above 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit will be sent home.
3. Equipment check - Players should have their equipment out and observable at check-in sites. Equipment will be checked while the player remains in the vehicle. Players missing any piece of equipment will not be permitted to train or play.
4. Wristband - Once approved, players will be provided a wristband to wear during the training session or game. Players may then exit the vehicle and proceed to the designated training area or field of play.

DEPARTURE

1. Staggered departure - players will be released from training through staggered departures by training group. Players are expected to proceed directly to their vehicles and to depart the training site. Departure from games will be similarly organized.

These protocols are in place to minimize risk to your players and your families. No exceptions will be made.
