



## 2021-2022 Futures Program Membership Plan

### MEMBERSHIP

1. Definitions
  - a. The “soccer year” is the period between August 1, 2021 to July 31, 2022.
  - b. There are three individual seasons within the “soccer year” – Fall, Winter, Spring
  - c. The membership term begins with whatever event occurs last; the first payment or August 1, 2021.
  - d. The membership term ends on July 31, 2022.
2. Membership is granted strictly to the participating child, also known as the “player”.
3. Membership is not transferable to another child or an adult.
4. Membership is terminated upon a child leaving the program.
5. Membership can be terminated by the club due to a disciplinary issue by child or parent.
6. The child is a member of the club and not of a specific team.
7. Participation in events is contingent upon compliance with the following documents.
  - a. Player Checklist
  - b. Futures Program Rules
8. Membership is contingent upon electronically signing these documents.
  - a. Membership Agreement
  - b. Membership Plan
  - c. Medical Release Form

### BENEFITS – TRAINING

1. Membership dues cover the cost for training. This includes but is not limited to the cost for coaches, fields, equipment, insurance, administrative support, etc.
2. The table below outlines the specific number of training sessions per season and per week.
3. FSCI reserves the right to vary the number of scheduled training sessions per week provided that the total number of scheduled training sessions per season are met.

## BENEFITS - SCHEDULE

1. The team calendar on our website is the only official source of events.
2. The table below lists the estimated start date and end date of each season within the membership term.
3. Any period not covered by a season is a break period.
4. FSCI reserves the right to adjust the start date and end date of each season provided that these dates fit within the current soccer year.

## MEMBERSHIP DUES AND PAYMENT DEADLINES

1. The annual membership dues and payment deadlines are outlined below.
2. The required uniform is not included in the membership dues.
3. There is a \$20 late fee for a missed payment deadline.
4. If a payment deadline is missed, a player ceases participation until payment is made. This applies regardless of previous payments.
5. For those that join after the "soccer year" begins, membership dues are prorated. The prorated amount is listed in the table below.

## DISCLAIMERS

1. There are no refunds regardless of reason or circumstance.
2. Schedule is subject to change due to weather or unforeseen circumstances.
3. FSCI will make a "best effort" to provide the number of scheduled practices and games within the scope of the force majeure clause in the membership agreement.
4. The number of games scheduled is the summation of league games, tournament games, and non-league games for each season.
5. The number of training sessions is the summation of outdoor practices, indoor practices, optional practices, video sessions, classroom sessions, or any session pertaining to teaching the game.
6. FSCI reserves the right to implement a player rotation system where each player dresses for at least the minimum number of scheduled games.
7. Based on merit, a player can play with different teams or age groups during the term.
8. FSCI reserves the right to combine age groups at any point during the membership term.
9. FSCI reserves the right to provide a substitute game, league, or tournament.
10. Financial assistance is available for children that qualify.
11. If a player misses a game or practice, FSCI will not provide another game or practice.
12. There exists a scenario where a child can be a member and not participate. It is the responsibility of the parent, legal guardian, and child to ensure compliance with all participation requirements to avoid this scenario.
13. The membership dues do not cover the entire cost of the program for a player. FSCI provides a limited number of free benefits not covered by membership dues that would otherwise cost an additional \$200 to \$1000 such as games, tournaments, administrative work performed by non-compensated staff, etc.
14. Any prorated membership dues cannot be combined with any discount or credit.
15. For automatic payments, the first payment is taken out immediately and subsequent payments are taken out on the 1st or 15th of the next month. The specific day is stated in the confirmation email and in the final webpage in the registration process. Automatic payment do NOT coincide with the payment deadlines in the membership plan.
16. A player must have all required uniform items and be prepared to wear the required items at any time.
17. A returning player that makes payment after the Payment 1 deadline runs the risk of forfeiting their jersey number and having to purchase new uniforms with a new jersey number.
