



2025-2026 Membership Plan Rec Academy Program

MEMBERSHIP

1. Definitions
 - a. The “soccer year” is the period between 7/1 of the current year to 6/30 of the following year.
 - b. The 2025-2026 “soccer year” is the period between 7/1/2025 and 6/30/2026.
 - c. There are four seasons within the “soccer year” named Fall, Winter 1, Winter 2, and Spring.
 - d. A child can participate in any individual season contingent upon payment.
2. The membership term is defined as follows.
 - a. The membership term begins with the event that occurs last; the first payment for an individual season or the first event of an individual season.
 - b. The membership term ends with the last event of an individual paid season.
3. Membership is granted strictly to the participating child, also known as the “player”.
4. Membership is not transferable to another child or an adult.
5. Membership terminates when a player leaves the program.
6. FSCI can terminate membership if a player or parent violates the Code of Conduct.
7. The player is a member of FSCI and not of a specific team.
8. Membership is contingent upon electronically signing these documents.
 - a. Membership Agreement
 - b. Membership Plan
 - c. Medical Release Form
9. The child is eligible to participate when the child is in good standing with payment and compliance with the following documents.
 - a. Rec Academy Program Rules
 - b. Code of Conduct
 - c. Player Checklist

BENEFITS – TRAINING & GAMES

1. Membership dues cover the cost of coaches, fields, equipment, insurance, practices, games, and administrative support.
2. The table below outlines the specific number of training sessions per season for a given membership level.
3. A membership level may not be available if enrollment is full or not offered.
4. FSCI reserves the right to alter the number of scheduled training sessions per week provided that the total number of training sessions per season fits within the range below.
5. Training sessions are either 45 minutes or 60 minutes long.

| Membership Level | Training Sessions | Games |

| Games Only | 0 | 6 or 7 |
| Games & 6 Practices | 6 or 7 | 6 or 7 |
| Games & 12 Practices | 12 to 14 | 6 or 7 |

BENEFITS - SCHEDULE

1. The team calendar on our website is the only official source of events.
2. The table below lists the estimated start date and end date of each season within the membership term.
3. FSCI reserves the right to adjust the start date and end date of each season provided that these dates fit within the “soccer year”.

MEMBERSHIP DUES

1. The membership dues for each individual season are outlined below.
2. FSCI reserves the right to offer early bird discounts on the membership dues prior to the first event of the season.

POLICIES

1. If there is a cancellation or a same-day schedule modification, FSCI will notify everyone via our social media pages. It is the responsibility of the parent and player to check our social media pages prior to the event.
2. If there is a full or partial cancellation of an event, we will attempt to make up the missed time. Makeup events can occur at any time or any day. We will make up the missed time by either adding makeup days, extending the time of existing days, or holding 2 sessions on 1 day.

- Parents need to monitor the weather forecast and arrange to have their child picked up if inclement weather causes issues during an outdoor or indoor event. Some outdoor locations do not have an available shelter. Therefore, it is important that rides are present in the event of inclement weather.
- Children can request to play on the same team with another child provided that both children are in the same birth year or in adjacent birth years and it makes sense developmentally.

ELIGIBILITY

The table below lists the birth years that are eligible to participate for a certain membership level.

| Games Only | 2021, 2020 |
| Games & 6 Practices | 2019 and older |
| Games & 12 Practices | 2019 and older |

PAYMENT DISCLAIMERS

- There are no refunds regardless of reason or circumstance.
- If we are unable to process a payment, there is a \$20 reinstatement fee.
- If a chargeback occurs, there is a \$50 fee.
- If there is a missing payment, the player is not in good standing. Therefore, the player ceases participation until FSCI receives the missing payment. This applies regardless of previous payments.
- The card holder's name must be one of the parents that signed the membership agreement.
- Any prorated membership dues cannot be combined with any other discount or credit.

OTHER DISCLAIMERS

- Schedule is subject to change due to weather or unforeseen circumstances.
- FSCI reserves the right to combine age groups at any point during the membership term.
- If a player misses an event, FSCI will not provide another event.
- There exists a scenario where a child can be a member and not participate. It is the responsibility of the parent, legal guardian, and child to ensure compliance with all participation eligibility requirements to avoid this scenario.
- The parent(s) consent to receiving communication from FSCI via email, text message, and phone.
